

## Quickstep Announces Retirement Of Chair

**28 August 2020:** Quickstep Holdings Limited (**ASX: QHL**), Australia's largest independent advanced composite manufacturer, today announces that the current Chair Mr. Tony Quick will retire from the Board of Directors effective Tuesday September 1<sup>st</sup>. Following a decision by the Board he will be replaced by Mr. Patrick Largier, whose appointment as a Non-Executive Director was announced in December 2019, effective the same day.

Mr. Quick has been the Chair of Quickstep Holdings Limited since 14 February 2013, during which time he has successfully guided the company through its transition to a high growth profitable aerospace manufacturing and technology business. He was also Executive Chair on an interim basis during a period of management transition in 2014.

Mr Quick commented that "I feel confident that the company is in very good hands with a highly capable Board of Directors with extensive skills and experience and an excellent management team."

Commenting on Mr. Quick's retirement newly appointed Chair Mr Largier said "the company and its shareholders have much to be grateful to Tony for.
