### **Issue of Shares and Options**

Xref Limited (ASX:XF1) (Xref or the Company) advises that it has today allotted a total of 1,000,000 new fully paid ordinary shares and 4,000,000 new options.

These shares have been issued to the Company's Chief Financial Officer (CFO – 500,000 shares) and Chief Operating Officer (COO – 500,000 shares) as a bonus to these senior executives in accordance with their employment contracts.

The options have been issued under the terms of Xref's Employee Option Plan, being 2,000,000 options to the Company's CFO and 2,000,000 options to its COO. These options have an exercise price of \$0.18 and will expire if not exercised by 15 January 2024. The option exercise price is the same price as the share issue announced to the market on 8 July 2020, being at a 7-day volume-weighted average price calculated on that date. The last sale price of Xref's shares prior to this announcement was \$0.15.

The shares and options have been issued to these two senior executives following a review of their performance for the previous financial year, and to incentivise them for the future in carrying out their key roles in the Company.

An Appendix 2A for the issue of these shares and options is attached.
