## **Results of Turners Automotive Group Limited's Annual Meeting**

At Turners Automotive Group's virtual shareholders meeting held on Wednesday 23 September 2020, shareholders were asked to vote on 3 resolutions, which were supported by the Board.

As required by NZX Listing Rule 6.1, all voting was conducted by a poll.

The resolutions passed by shareholders were:

- That Baker Tilley Staples Rodway be reappointed as auditors;
- Re-elect John Roberts as a Director of the Company; and
- Re-elect Matthew Harrison as a Director of the Company.

Detail of the total number of votes cast in person or by a proxy holder are:
