Non-executive Director Resignation

Superloop Limited (**ASX: SLC**) (**Superloop**) announces that Mr Greg Baynton has advised the Board that he will resign as a non-executive Director of Superloop with effect from the conclusion of Superloop's Annual General Meeting on 18 November 2020.

Bevan Slattery, Chairman of Superloop said: "Greg has been a valued member of the Board and made a considerable contribution to the Company, especially in its listing on the ASX in 2015 and as Chair of the Audit Committee from that time until March 2020. We wish him well in his future endeavours".
