Annual General Meeting – Letter to Shareholders and Proxy Form

Pureprofile Limited (ASX: PPL) ("Pureprofile" or the "Company") advises that its Annual General Meeting ("AGM") will be held on Friday, 29 January 2021 at 10:00AM (AEDT) as a virtual meeting.

The holding of the AGM in January 2021 is consistent with ASIC's "no action" position enabling companies to defer the holding of their AGM by up to two months.

Given the health concerns attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic and the guidelines and restrictions issued by Australian state and federal governments, the Company considers that it is appropriate to hold its AGM as a virtual meeting in a manner that is consistent with the temporary modifications to the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) introduced by the Commonwealth Treasurer.

This information is based on circumstances as at 24 December 2020. The Company advises Shareholders to monitor the Company's ASX announcements platform and website for any updates.

The Company further advises that, in accordance with section 5(1)(f) of the Corporations (Coronavirus Economic Response) Determination (No. 3) 2020 made by the Commonwealth Treasurer on 21 September 2020, the Notice of AGM will not be sent as a hard copy and is instead available to Shareholders to view and download on the following page of the Company's website: <https://pureprofile.investorportal.com.au/>.

Virtual Meeting

If you wish to virtually attend the AGM (which will be broadcast as a live webinar), please **pre-register** in advance for the virtual meeting here:

After registering, you will receive a confirmation containing information on how to attend the virtual meeting on the day of the AGM.

Shareholders will be able to vote and ask questions at the virtual meeting. Shareholders are also encouraged to submit questions in advance of the AGM to the Company. Questions must be submitted in writing to the Company Secretary at Lee.Tamplin@automicgroup.com.au at least 48 hours before the AGM.

Your vote is important

All resolutions will be decided on a poll. The poll will be conducted based on votes submitted by proxy and at the Meeting.

Shareholders attending the meeting virtually and wishing to vote on the day of the meeting can find further instructions on how to do so in the Notice of Meeting. Alternatively, shareholders are

strongly encouraged to complete and submit their vote by proxy by using one of the following methods:

Click on 'View Meetings' – 'Vote'. YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

The name and address shown above is as it appears on the Company's share register. STEP 1 – APPOINT A PROXY

If you wish to appoint someone other than the Chair of the Meeting as your proxy, please write the name of that Individual or body corporate. A proxy need not be a Shareholder of the Company. Otherwise if you leave this box blank, the Chair of the Meeting will be appointed as your proxy by default.

DEFAULT TO THE CHAIR OF THE MEETING

Any directed proxies that are not voted on a poll at the Meeting will default to the Chair of the Meeting, who is required to vote these proxies as directed. Any undirected proxies that default to the Chair of the Meeting will be voted according to the instructions set out in this Proxy Voting Form, including where the Resolutions are connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of KIM.

STEP 2 - VOTES ON ITEMS OF BUSINESS

You may direct your proxy how to vote by marking one of the boxes opposite each item of business. All your shares will be voted in accordance with such a direction unless you indicate only a portion of voting rights are to be voted on any item by inserting the percentage or number of shares you wish to vote in the appropriate box or boxes. If you do not mark any of the boxes on the items of business, your proxy may vote as he or she chooses. If you mark more than one box on an item your vote on that item will be invalid.

APPOINTMENT OF SECOND PROXY

You may appoint up to two proxies. If you appoint two proxies, you should complete two separate Proxy Voting Forms and specify the percentage or number each proxy may exercise. If you do not specify a percentage or number, each proxy may exercise half the votes. You must return both Proxy Voting Forms together. If you require an additional Proxy Voting Form, contact Automic Registry Services.

SIGNING INSTRUCTIONS

Individual: Where the holding is in one name, the Shareholder must sign.

Joint holding: Where the holding is in more than one name, all Shareholders should sign.

Power of attorney: If you have not already lodged the power of attorney with the registry, please attach a certified photocopy of the power of attorney to this Proxy Voting Form when you return it.

Companies: To be signed in accordance with your Constitution. Please sign in the appropriate box which indicates the office held by you.

Email Address: Please provide your email address in the space provided.

By providing your email address, you elect to receive all communications despatched by the Company electronically (where legally permissible) such as a Notice of Meeting, Proxy Voting Form and Annual Report via email.
