1. Introduction

The Annual Bonus Plan is designed to reward employees for achievement of their individual goals and KPIs and for overall company achievement against agreed targets. The Annual Bonus Plan is designed to reward high performance, and for both individual and company performance there is the opportunity to overachieve against the target bonus amount.

Employees will be included in the Annual Bonus Plan based on role and contractual employment terms. All Bonuses are payable at the discretion of oOh! and subject to the Annual Bonus Plan Rules (see section 6 below). Bonuses for employees who join or leave employment with the Company during the Bonus Plan period are subject to special provision under the Annual Bonus Plan Rules.

For 2020, modifications have been introduced to account for the impacts of COVID-19 on the market conditions and Company results. This included revised measures and a decision to issue any bonus amount as equity (unrestricted shares) instead of cash. Unrestricted shares are ordinary shares in the Company that are not subject to restrictions on sale.

2. Bonus targets, Company measures and weightings

The usual annual target bonus amount for each individual is as specified in their employment contract or subsequent remuneration letters.

Bonuses are at the discretion of the Company and in exercise of that discretion, given the circumstances of 2020:

- the actual **Target Bonus** for 2020 only has been reset to be equal to 50% of the usual annual target bonus amount, with no differentiation across the organisation between ELT, senior leaders or others; and
- the usual past measure for Company performance (based on an EBITDA target) was replaced with 3 new **Company performance measures**. These are set out in the table below, with performance thresholds to payment and additional incentives and caps for overachievement.

The **Company performance multiplier** based on achievement (including partial achievement or overachievement) against the Company performance measures is used to determine both:

- the overall bonus pool; and
- the percentage to be applied to every employee's Target Bonus for 2020 to set the **Base Target Bonus** that will apply at 100% individual performance.

An **individual performance multiplier** then applies to that Base Target Bonus for each employee to determine the **Final Bonus Amount** to be allocated to them. If a threshold individual performance and contribution standard is not achieved, no bonus will be payable. Otherwise, this individual performance multiplier will range from 80% to 120% based on senior leader evaluation of performance and contribution.

3. Final Bonus Amount

The Final Bonus Amount for each employee will be determined by multiplying the 2020 Target Bonus for that employee (\$) by the Company Performance multiplier (%) by the Individual Performance multiplier (%) (cumulatively).

4. Payment in shares

The Final Bonus Amount will be paid in oOh! shares. The number of these shares is based on the Volume Weighted Average Price (VWAP) of oOh! shares traded on the ASX calculated over the 180 trading days from 1 January to 30 June 2020.

The number of shares to be issued is therefore determined by the Final Bonus Amount divided by that VWAP. The actual \$ value of the shares issued will in fact be the market value of the shares on the day they are issued.

5. Superannuation

The total amount of any cash bonus payable incorporates any legislated and payable superannuation, i.e. comprises a cash component and a superannuation component. Payment of any bonus in equity does not attract legislative superannuation.

6. Bonus Plan rules

- 1. The Annual Bonus Plan operates on a calendar year basis, i.e. 1 January to 31 December.
- 2. Bonus payments will be confirmed after the annual performance evaluation and remuneration review processes have been conducted.
- 3. Bonus payments will be made no later than the end of March in the year following a performance period, i.e. 2020 Bonuses will be paid by end of March 2021.
- 4. The Annual Bonus Plan will be reviewed annually by the ELT and oOh! Board to ensure alignment to oOh!'s strategy and goals for the year.
- 5. Eligibility for participation and receipt of bonus payments under the Annual Bonus Plan requires strict compliance to oOh!'s code of conduct, company policies and compliance with all relevant legislative and regulatory requirements. Non-compliance, as determined by oOh! ELT will constitute grounds for cancellation of Bonus payment eligibility.

- 6. Eligibility for a Bonus payment requires the participant to be employed and not under notice of resignation or termination, until at least the completion of the performance period of the Annual Bonus Plan is achieved (i.e. the last day of the calendar year).
- 7. The Company reserves the right not to pay a Bonus to an employee who terminates their employment post completion of the calendar year but before payment of bonuses with the intent to take employment with a competitor.
- 8. Only in the cases of retirement or bona fide redundancy will an employee be eligible for a bonus (either in part or in whole) when having left (or signalled the intent to leave) the employment of the Company during a calendar year.
- 9. Employees must complete three months active service prior to the end of the Bonus period to be eligible for a prorated Bonus in that calendar year.
- 10. Employees who have a change in Target Bonus amount during the calendar year will be paid any Bonus based on a Target Bonus prorated across the relevant dollar amounts based on the time spent under each arrangement.
- 11. The Company reserves the right to revise or terminate any of the provisions of this Annual Bonus Plan or to terminate the Annual Bonus Plan itself at any time for reason.
- 12. The issuance of these rules or other guidelines for any year does not in any way commit the Company to pay a similar kind of Bonus in any subsequent year.
- 13. All Bonuses are payable at the absolute discretion of the Company.
- 14. All Bonuses may be paid as either cash or equity (shares) at the discretion of the Company.
