## **Update on Curragh Fatality**

We acknowledge the significant impact this incident has had on Donald's family and loved ones and we again express our deepest sympathies to Donald's family and co-workers.

CCPL is reviewing the charges, however, as these matters are before the Court, it is not appropriate for us to comment further at this time.
