INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION AGAINST THE REPUBLIC OF GHANA – UPDATE

Cassius Mining Limited ("Cassius" or "the Company") (ASX Code: CMD) advises that the initial steps of appointing an international neutral seat for the arbitral proceedings against the Republic of Ghana have now commenced.

Whilst the Company is in ongoing discussions with funders in respect of finalising the funding arrangements and entering into a final binding agreement, the Company has engaged Quinn Emmanuel Trial Lawyers to conduct the litigation.

By letter dated 24 May 2021 to the President and the Attorney General of the Republic of Ghana, Quinn Emmanuel Trial Lawyers have proposed, on behalf of the Company, the London Court of International Arbitration (LCIA) institution as appointing authority and administrator of the arbitration.
