APPOINTMENT OF NEW CHAIRMAN

Centrex Metals Limited (ASX:CXM) ("Centrex" or "Company") is pleased to announce that the Board has unanimously appointed Mr Peter Hunt FCA as the Company's new independent Non-Executive Chairman, effective today.

Mr Hunt was appointed as a Non-Executive Director of the Company on 15 December 2020. He was a former consultant to BDO Adelaide, which merged with PKF Adelaide of which Mr Hunt was a senior partner. He is a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia.
