

ASX Announcement 12th July 2021

COVID-19 UPDATE

Range International Ltd (ASX: RAN) (**Company** or **Range International**), manufacturer of Re>Pal[™] 'zero-waste', recycled plastic pallets, provides this update on the effects of Covid-19 on its operation in Pasuruan, East Java, Indonesia.

As of 9th July 2021, according to the World Health Organisation, Indonesia had nearly 2,500,000 cases of Covid-19. Since the commencement of the pandemic, Re>Pal Indonesia has been taking precautions to ensure as safe an environment as possible for staff including Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), hand sanitising, testing and isolation for employees showing symptoms and careful shift rotation and planning. Recently, there has been a spike in cases across Indonesia. As of 9th July 2021, the Company has decided to conduct full Covid-19 Antigen tests on all staff at the factory.

110 out of a total of 126 staff have currently been tested, with 28 staff returning positive results. Of the 28 positive staff, numbers were split evenly over full time and part time staff. The infected staff members will now isolate at home. They will be tested again in 10 day's time and must return a negative test before returning to work. None of these 'positive staff' were symptomatic for Covid-19 at the time of testing.

The impact on the operations of the Company is currently minimal. The Company will reduce 1 shift per day for the time being, however anticipates making up this loss in production by extending other shifts with overtime and employing new daily workers as required. Company managers in the factory will ensure that the Company maintains a safe environment and one that is as productive as possible given the current situation.

This situation, with the increases in Covid-19 across Indonesia, is naturally extremely fluid and one that we are managing as carefully as we can. There may be intermittent losses in production as a result and there may also be reductions in raw material availability due to restrictions in collecting waste. The business has already been putting in place strategies to mitigate supply interruptions with the PT Aalborg Industrie Indonesia initiative announced in the March 2021 4C and we are also looking to expand our partnership with TetraPak.

We will continue our ongoing testing and mitigation strategies and should there be any material impact on production we will update the market accordingly.

This announcement has been approved for release by the Board.

Range is a manufacturer of plastic pallets, trading as Re>Pal™. Our ThermoFusion™ technology allows Re>Pal™ to make 'zero waste', 100% recycled and recyclable plastic.

Range currently has production lines operating in its East Java factory in Indonesia and sells its pallets under the brand Re>Pal™, supplying pallets into Indonesia and across Asia/ globally.
