

Alligator Samphire Drilling and Corporate Update

Alligator Energy (ASX: AGE, 'Alligator' or 'the Company') is pleased to provide the following updates regarding the timing of Samphire drilling and assay results, corporate and other exploration matters:

Samphire Drilling and Assay results

- Sonic core drilling at the Samphire Uranium Project near Whyalla, SA, is nearing completion, with the final hole number 14 underway. The drilling has been very successful with excellent core recovery from the sonic method, and we thank Alligator's technical and field team, and the experienced drilling crew for their work.
- Geological logging and splitting of cores for sampling and assay is continuing.
- Receipt of finalised assays for the first hole is anticipated during the next two weeks. The assay lab has reported that their work and timing has been impacted by COVID isolation requirements for a number of employees.
- Alligator has secured the services of a PFN logging contractor for the upcoming rotary drilling program targeted for late February 2022.

Chief Operating Officer

- As announced in October 2021, Dr Andrea Marsland-Smith is joining Alligator as Chief Operating Officer, with accountability and oversight of the Samphire Uranium Project and our broader exploration. We are pleased to advise that **Dr Marsland-Smith will commence her role with the company on 1 February 2022**. Andrea's wealth of experience in discovering and advancing uranium resources, her geological, technical and operational management of ISR projects, in conjunction with her wide uranium industry and engagement experience will be of paramount value to Alligator.

Alligator Rivers Geophysics contractor secured

- The Company has secured the services of Daishat Geodetic Surveyors to undertake a ground gravity survey on its Nabarlek North project post the wet season this year.
- Additional support and technical services are being identified for an enhanced work program planned for this year.
