Court Approves Scheme

Class Limited (ASX:CL1) (**Class**) is pleased to announce that the Supreme Court of New South Wales (the **Court**) has today made orders approving the scheme of arrangement under which HUB24 Limited (ASX:HUB) (**HUB24**) will acquire all of the shares in Class (**Scheme**).

Class expects to lodge an office copy of the Court orders pursuant to section 411(10) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission on Monday, 7 February 2022 at which time the Scheme will become legally effective. If this occurs, Class will apply for its shares to be suspended from trading on the Australian Securities Exchange with effect from the close of trade on Monday, 7 February 2022.
