PainChek Ltd (ASX Code: PCK) - Request for Trading Halt

PainChek Ltd ACN 146 035 127 (**PainChek**) requests that a trading halt be granted by the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in respect of its securities in accordance with Listing Rule 17.1.

PainChek provides the following information regarding this request:

- (a) the reason for the trading halt is that PainChek intends to make an announcement regarding a non-renounceable entitlement offer and placement (ASX Announcement);
- (b) PainChek requests that the trading halt continues until the earliest of:
 - (1) PainChek making an ASX announcement regarding the outcome of the placement;
 - (2) before the opening of trading on Friday 24 June 2022; or
 - (3) PainChek separately requests that the trading halt be lifted;
- (c) PainChek expects that the ASX Announcement will be made as soon as possible and, in any event, prior to the opening of trading on Friday 24 June 2022;
- (d) PainChek considers that the trading halt is necessary as otherwise trading in PainChek's securities would continue on an uninformed basis; and
- (e) PainChek is not aware of any reason why a trading halt should not be granted, or any other information necessary to inform the market about the requested trading halt.
