NEW ENERGY SOLAR (ASX:NEW)

UPDATE ON U.S. ASSET SALE PROCESS

New Energy Solar Limited (**ASX:NEW**) advises that following the competitive asset sale process announced on 28 February 2022 it is granting a period of exclusivity to a preferred potential acquirer of 100% of NEW's interests in its portfolio of 14 U.S. solar assets. The potential acquirer, MN8 Energy (**MN8**), was established inside Goldman Sachs Asset Management and formerly known as Goldman Sachs Renewable Power LLC. MN8 owns and operates a fleet of more than 800 solar projects representing greater than 2.3 gigawatts of clean renewable power. MN8 is granted exclusivity until the end of August 2022 during which time NEW and MN8 will negotiate binding agreements and file the required regulatory approvals.

In the event the transaction agreements are finalised and executed, NEW will call an extraordinary general meeting to seek shareholder approval for the transaction.

Key commercial terms of the transaction will be disclosed upon the execution of binding transaction agreements and completion will be subject to NEW shareholder approval, customary financier consents and U.S. regulatory approval.

While the asset sale process is proceeding to a final stage, there is no certainty a transaction will be completed.
