NEW ENERGY SOLAR (ASX: NEW) UNAUDITED NET ASSET VALUE AS AT 25 NOVEMBER 2022

New Energy Solar's weekly estimated unaudited net asset value (**NAV**) as at 25 November 2022 was A\$0.21 per share.

New Energy Solar's directors have elected to make this disclosure to the market to provide shareholders with additional information about changes in the estimated NAV of their shares due primarily to the \$0.82/share capital return and movements in the AUD:USD foreign exchange rate.

This weekly unaudited NAV estimate has been calculated by reference to New Energy Solar's un audited NAV (being A\$1.11 per share as at 30 September 2022 based on an AUD:USD foreign exchange rate of 0.6400), adjusting for changes in the AUD:USD foreign exchange rate, the \$0.82c per share capital return announced on 21 November 2022 and to be paid on 1 December 2022, and the number of shares on issue since that date.

The weekly unaudited NAV estimates may vary from the estimated future capital return estimate of \$0.205/share because of the contingent nature of certain liabilities which are not yet reflected in the weekly NAV estimates. Specifically, the capital return estimate has been updated for the Company's future liabilities (which includes future US tax payable), future investment management fees and other operating costs, and winding up fees and costs. It is important to note that the weekly NAV estimate may also vary to the extent these estimated costs are more or less than the Company's estimates or if resulting residual US dollars (if any) are converted to Australian dollars at an exchange rate that is more or less than the current assumption.
