FUM Announcement – 1 October to 31 December 2022

Net flows remain positive in challenging market

Positive net flows

During the quarter, Australian Ethical reported positive net flows of \$0.16 billion. The quarterly net flows have been driven predominantly by superannuation flows, whilst managed funds flows have been supressed by cautious market sentiment related to market volatility.

Funds under management

Funds under management (FUM) at 31 December 2022 was \$8.37 billion, an increase of 35% from 30 June 2022.

FUM during the quarter was bolstered by the successor fund transfer (SFT) of Christian Super, which added \$1.93 billion to Australian Ethical's FUM. Investment performance for the quarter was \$0.11 billion.


