The trading halt is to last until the earlier of the Company releasing an announcement, or the commencement of trading on Monday, 27 March 2023.

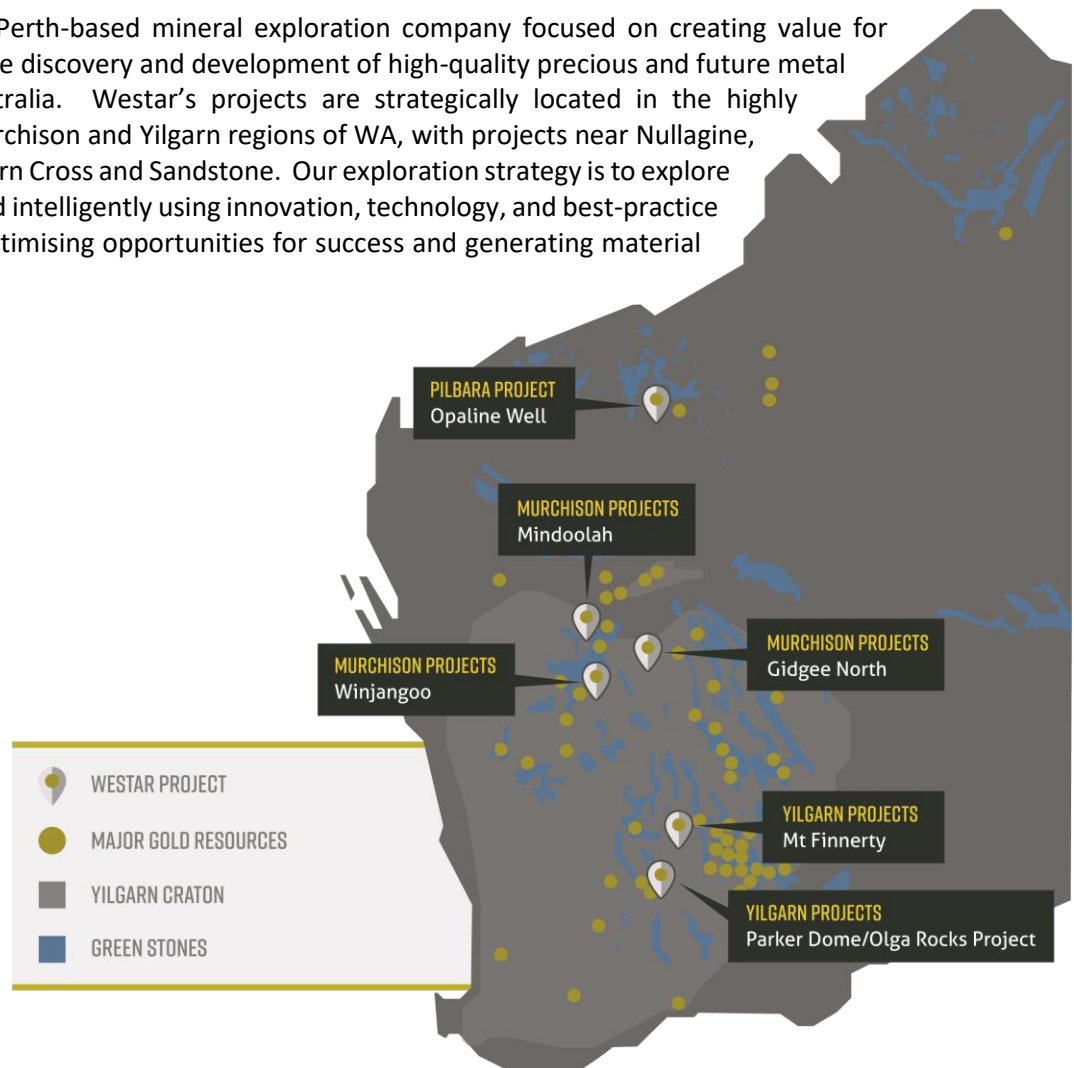
The Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
