Tala Hamza Zinc Project – Further Advances

Terramin Australia Limited (ASX: TZN) (**Terramin**) is pleased to advise that the Algerian Government has issued an “Executive Decree of Public Utility” (**Decree**) in respect of the Tala Hamza Zinc Project (**Tala Hamza**). The Decree was signed by the Prime Minister of Algeria, Mr Aimene Benabderrahmane.

The issue of the Decree is an important stepping stone for Tala Hamza as it triggers the process for the acquisition of the land by the Algerian Government, which covers the footprint of the Tala Hamza Mining Permit. This land of an area of approximately 234 hectares will then be made available to the project to undertake its operations. The land will support all the project mining and processing operations as well as direct ramp access to a highway (which is currently under construction) that leads directly to the Port of Bejaia (approximately 15km to the north) and important electricity and gas infrastructure.

This positive move by the Algerian Government follows the Algerian mining regulator issuing the Mining Permit for Tala Hamza.

Commenting on the issue of the Decree, Terramin’s Executive Officer, Mr Martin Janes, said:

“Terramin is pleased that the Algerian Government has continued to show a strong commitment to the Tala Hamza Zinc Project by facilitating the issue of the Decree. The Decree will allow access to all land defined by the Mining Permit.”

On behalf of the Terramin board and management team we would like to thank the Algerian government for their continued assistance.”

ABOUT TALA HAMZA ZINC PROJECT

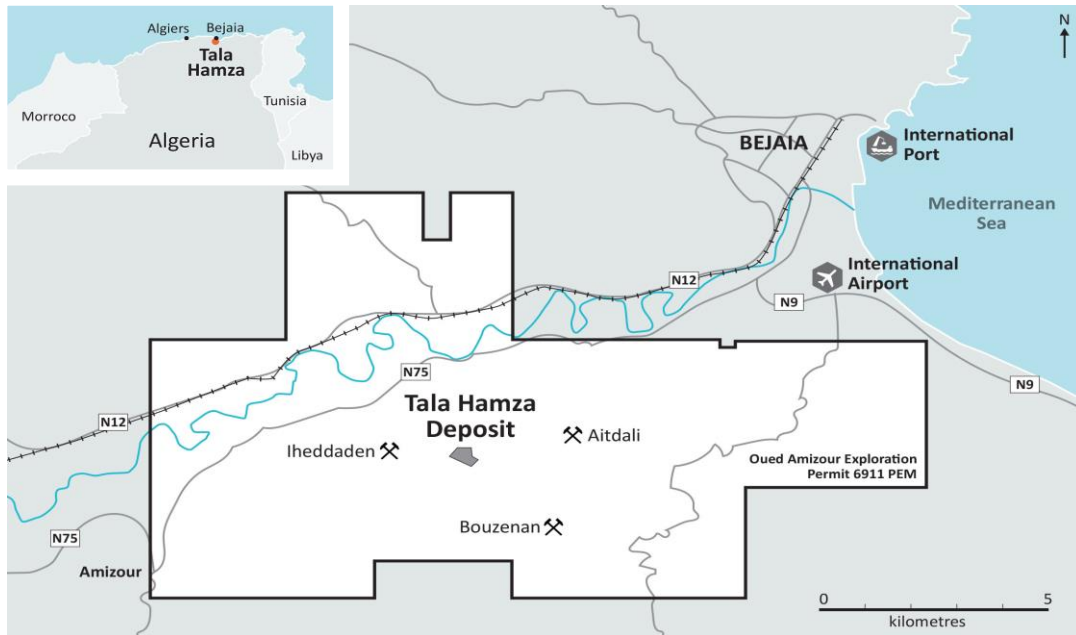
Tala Hamza is located on the Mediterranean coast of Algeria, approximately 15 kilometres from the port city of Bejaia. Bejaia has a deep-water port facility and an international airport. The project is close to major rail, road and energy infrastructure (Figure 1).

Tala Hamza is a world class ore body and is now proceeding towards development, it will become one of the largest developing zinc and lead deposits in the world.

Additional upside exists as well with the Tala Hamza deposit remaining open to the east and south-east, allowing potential to expand production. In addition, the Tala Hamza district is heavily mineralised and there are a number of nearby under-explored zinc targets in the vicinity of our Mining Permit that provide us with high exploration potential.

Terramin is enthusiastic about the next phase in its development of Tala Hamza and looks forward to an exciting and prosperous future for the company.
