- Both a precious and an industrial metal
- Like gold, silver is a secure store of wealth
 - rising in value due to global insecurities and financial uncertainty
- Forecast industrial use is exponential
 - in solar panels and as silver solder for electrification
- Washington-based Silver Institute**
 - demand for silver grew 18% year-on-year (from 2021) to a record high of 1.24 billion ounces,
 - 2022 was under-supplied to the tune of 237.7Moz, the most significant on record, and second straight year of silver deficit







- Maronan Project is located in the prolific North-West Minerals Province, Queensland, Australia

Maronan – 3 Key Mineralised Horizons









Maronan – 3D Ore Block Models

Maronan is a High Grade Silver with Lead Deposit




Silver - Lead Resource*

 - key to any early development





Shallow Starter Zone – Eastern Horizon Long Section & Cross Section





- Any future mine at Maronan is likely to access first ore from the Starter Zone, where mineralisation reaches to within 90m of surface
- Assays continue to demonstrate strong geological and grade continuity as well as high grades of silver and lead
- Horizons remain open at depth






Copper Gold

 0.8g/t Au (2.3% CuEq)* at 1% Cu Cut-off
- Contains 253kT CuEq**
- ISCG style copper-gold system (eg Eloise, Jericho, Mount Hope, Nil Desperandum)

MMA 2023 Drilling Phase

- Demonstrated improved continuity of copper mineralisation which remains open at depth
- Provided samples conducting preliminary metallurgical testwork





Copper-Gold Mineralisation



- Deeper drilling continues to intersect broad intervals of mineralisation
- Existing DHEM plate extends at least 300m below current drilling
- Existing resource is pyrrhotite dominant exploring for change to higher grade chalcopyrite dominant zones (like Eloise, Carnaby)
- 2016 scoping study showed potential to mine Copper-Gold resource utilising the same infrastructure as the Lead-Silver resource.



Near Term Activity and News flow



Assess the results from the 2023 field program



- Assays pending on:
 - Five holes from 2023 Exploration Program
 - Soil sampling of the Northern EM anomaly
- Establish priorities for further drilling

Progress Mine Related Studies



- Update the resource model
- Revise 2016 Scoping Study with latest resource and current cost information
- Conduct metallurgical Cu-Au research
- Undertake baseline environmental surveys
