### About SunRice's structure

The structure of SunRice contains non-standard elements including its dual class share structure comprising A Class Shares and B Class Shares.

A Class Shares confer on their holders the right to vote at general meetings but no right to dividends. A Class Shares are not quoted on ASX and may only be held by rice growers who meet the production quotas prescribed by the SunRice constitution. No person may hold more than 5 A Class Shares. In practical terms the voting rights held by A Class Shareholders give those shareholders the right to control the election of directors and any changes to SunRice's constitution.

B Class Shares are quoted on ASX and confer on their holders the right to receive dividends, as determined by the directors from time to time. Holders of B Class Shares do not generally have the right to vote at general meetings of SunRice. This means B Class Shareholders have no right to vote on the election of directors of SunRice. No person may hold more than 10% of the total number of B Class Shares on issue.

Dear fellow rice growers

**Increase to the lower end of the 2023 (CY23) Riverina rice pool range**

After a cold start to the season which has caused our growers some early issues, this year's crop continues to look positive with some warmer weather on the horizon.

I am writing to update you in relation to the 2023 (CY23) Riverina rice pool – which is the 500,000 tonne crop harvested earlier this year that the SunRice Group is currently processing and marketing.

You may recall that on 24 February we announced that the range for the CY23 pool was \$390 to \$450 per tonne for medium grain Reiziq. I am pleased to announce an increase in the lower end range to \$410 per tonne (new range from \$410 to \$450 per tonne). The SunRice Group has been able to increase this lower end of the range in light of favourable circumstances in market and across the Rice Pool Business.

The upper end of the range is unchanged at \$450 per tonne. Given this increase in the lower end of the range, a one-off payment of \$20 per tonne will be made to participating growers on or around 1 December 2023.
