

Shekel Brainweigh (ASX: SBW\Shekel\the Company) Q1-2024 Business Update

SIGNIFICANT ORDERS AND TRIALS MARK STRONG START TO 2024.

Shekel received a significant order of US\$ 500,000 for its Smart Carts kits, an order for Smart Coolers in the UK (US\$ 294,000), and started trials of its new Sentinel Smart Bay and its new Smart Tray.

Shekel showcased its range of retail automation solutions at EuroCis24, the leading European retail exhibition in Dusseldorf Germany. Following its launch at NRF24, Sentinel gets early traction with a global European retailer.

Highlights

- Shekel booth at EuroCis24 showcased our suite of automated retail solutions including Smart Cooler, Smart Cart, Smart Tray and Smart Bay. Shekel demonstrated for the second time its breakthrough AI based technology on Sentinel Smart Bay. Sentinel is an innovative, cost effective solution for Scan&Go application, to target major pain of loss prevention at retail stores.
- A global European retailer ordered a first trial with Sentinel. The trial will be conducted at the retailer headquarter technology center in Germany.
- Cust2Mate, a Smart Cart manufacturer placed a second order for weighing kits for its smart cart. The order is valued at US\$ 470,000, and marks continued demand from this customer.
- A major order for Smart Coolers was received from Shekel's distributor in the UK, Scobbie- McKintosh. The order for 42 Smart Coolers is valued at US\$ 294,000.
 All 42 Coolers were delivered to the UK.
- Together with Sentinel, Shekel showcased its technology solution for Smart Tray, a new way to identify multiple products purchased on a single tray.
 The first orders of the Trays followed soon after the exhibition.



Significant Order for Smart Coolers for the UK Market

Shekel received the first order for 42 Smart Coolers from its UK partner, Scobie-McIntosh, as part of an expected total order of 158 Smart Coolers. The order of US\$ 294,000 (A\$ 450,000) has been completed successfully, with all fridges delivered and paid for during Q1, 2024. Following the installation of the Coolers, a SaaS monthly fee will be applied, to allow for real time transaction data, and operational efficiency.

Shekel advanced patented technology in AI and ML (Machine Learning) is the enabling technology powering the Smart Cooler, as well as Shekel's other solutions for retail automation. Shekel's Smart Coolers being chosen by a global retailer with vast experience in automated retail and AI, is a strong testament for the advanced capabilities developed by Shekel.

This order represents a major milestone in commercializing our smart coolers solutions to a top tier client, and following months of testing. Smart Cart Kits Order

Following the previous order for Smart Cart kits from Cust2Mate (www.cust2mate.com), Shekel is pleased to report of a receipt of a second order of kits valued at **US\$ 470,000**. All kits are scheduled to be delivered during 2024.

As previously presented, a few global research groups forecast significant growth in the Smart Cart segment. Smart Cart is predicted to lead the trends in retail automation in the coming years. Shekel is a dominant supplier of weighing +AI based kits to this market. With the expected approval of "Legal for Trade", the use of weigh based kits is expected to grow exponentially.

Sentinel Trial

Following its launch at NRF 24, the Sentinel was showcased at Eurocis 24 in Dusseldorf Germany. The technology and solution got major attraction, and during the show the Company was invited to a trial at a global European retailer. The trial will be conducted in the coming months at the retailer's technology center in Germany.



Sentinel is an easily retrofitted in-store product that enables accurate Scan & Go and prevents loss for self-shopping applications. This innovative solution marks a significant advancement in self-shopping checkout security, revolutionizing in-store technology implementation with cost-effective retrofitting capabilities.

Based on Shekel's advanced weighing technology and artificial intelligence (AI), Sentinel transforms existing retail shelf-racks into intelligent bays, enabling traditional grocery stores to seamlessly transition to self-shopping environments at a fraction of the usual cost. This addresses critical retail challenges such as shrinkage and loss prevention, which have the growth of frictionless and mobile-checkout options, hindered despite their popularity, and the clear benefits it offers to both retailers and consumers.

Equipped with high-definition load sensors and an AI-driven security module, Sentinel discretely installs and operates at the base of existing store shelves, detecting and analyzing every interaction between shoppers and products. This system ensures that items taken from shelves correspond with the vision system, effectively reducing incidences of misscanning and theft. The result is a significant decrease in shrinkage and labor costs, while offering customers a streamlined and error-free shopping experience.

"This trial will be the second one we are launching for Sentinel and we are very pleased with the early traction of Sentinel in a trial at major retailer in Europe" said Nir Leshem, Shekel' GM. "Sentinel represents a successful development effort maturing into a valuable solution, and an enabling technology to overcome the barriers limiting self-shopping at a substantially lower cost."

Smart Tray Orders

At Eurocis, Shekel also demonstrated for the first time its solution for Smart Tray. A Smart Tray is an automated solution that allows shoppers to place multiple items into a tray at retailers. The tray automatically detects and calculates the transaction. Shekel's technology is added to the tray to verify the validity and accuracy of the tray calculation.

The Smart Tray received interest from retailers and Smart Shelf providers, and first few orders followed the exhibition.
