Biosecurity update

Inghams Group Limited (ASX: ING) (Inghams, Company) notes media reports relating to the detection of the avian influenza virus, otherwise known as bird flu, at a layer egg (table egg) farm in western Sydney, New South Wales.

Inghams has no commercial broiler chicken farms located in New South Wales. As a result, there is no impact to Ingham's operations or its supply chain, and the Company continues to supply the market as usual. The Company has chicken breeder farms and a small Turkey operation in New South Wales, and while these are not in the affected greater Sydney area, as a precaution Inghams has moved to a state of heightened biosecurity vigilance to mitigate against any potential risks.

The enhanced biosecurity measures implemented throughout Ingham's Victorian operations, as notified in the Company's ASX announcement dated 22 May, remain in place. These measures are in addition to its already strict standard protocols and include restricted access to all Victorian operations (livestock and processing).
