Update Curragh Complex - 2020 Incident

Coronado Global Resources Inc. (ASX: CRN) (“Coronado” or the “Company”) advises that on 15 July, 2024 the charges against its subsidiary, Coronado Curragh Pty Ltd (“CCPL”) (as the operator of the Curragh Complex), as set out in the complaint issued by the Office of Workplace Health and Safety Prosecutor (“OWHSP”), in relation to the death of Mr Donald Rabbitt in an incident in January 2020 (“January 2020 Incident”), were formally dismissed in the Brisbane Magistrates Court, signifying the conclusion of the proceedings against CCPL.

The complaint that had been issued against one of the Company’s former employees in relation to the January 2020 Incident was previously dismissed at the end of 2023.

Coronado acknowledges the significant impact this incident has had on Donald’s family and loved ones and again expresses its deepest sympathies to Donald’s family and co-workers.
