Contracted Utilisation Update

NEXTDC Limited (**ASX: NXT**) ("**NEXTDC**" or "the **Company**") is pleased to advise that following recent customer wins, the Company's contracted utilisation¹ has increased by 23.6MW (16%) since 31 December 2023 to 172.6MW.

NEXTDC's NSW/ACT data centre region has benefited the most from the increased contracted utilisation and is now at 20% of total planned capacity^{1,2}.

Revenue recognition for the majority of the new customer contract wins is expected to progressively commence during FY27, following completion and commissioning of additional data halls over time, and to contribute at full run rate from FY28 onwards.

As a result of these customer contract wins, the Company's forward order book now stands at a record level of 86.6MW³.
