Market commentary

The S&P/ASX 200 Accumulation Index declined -3.2% in December as the anticipated 'Santa Rally' failed to materialise. Market sentiment was largely influenced by the US Federal Reserve's more hawkish stance at its December meeting, signalling fewer rate cuts than previously expected. In addition, China's weak economic data and further disappointing stimulus measures further weighed on shares, particularly mining stocks.

Despite ending 2024 on a negative note, Australian shares posted a positive overall return for the calendar year, rising +11.4%. Gains were predominantly driven by an expansion in price-to-earnings (P/E) multiples. However, as P/E multiples approach record highs, continued market momentum will likely rely on stronger earnings growth from companies.
