In line with technological development, ANTAM utilizes a digital-based application, Supersafe, to support data reporting of unsafe conditions and unsafe acts. This application also serves as a public information platform regarding the latest health, safety, and environmental (HSE) regulations and news.

"The utilization of technology not only increases operational effectiveness but also ensures stronger safety supervision," Hartono explained.

In addition to safety, ANTAM also prioritizes employee health. Annual programs such as medical check-ups are routinely carried out, including medical risk mitigation for employees with certain health conditions.
