Lincoln secures \$200k R&D rebate for Kookaburra Value Add Development

The objective of this project is the development of new processes for the production of a series of specialty graphite products including dry or conductivity lubricants, carbon brushes, plastics, power metallurgy, drilling fluids, alkali batteries and foundry materials, as well as a very high grade purified spherical graphite product suitable for use in the manufacturing of Battery Anode Material (BAM) from the Kookaburra Gully (KG) graphite resource.

The R&D rebate will support further development of the production of High Purity Graphite as well as support the current assaying of historic core samples from Minbrie for copper, lead, zinc, and silver, for which assay results will be reported over the next 8 to 10 weeks as results emerge.


