

During the month to 31 December 2016 Glennon Small Companies Ltd delivered a gross portfolio return of 0.58%, while the S&P/ASX Small Ordinaries Accumulation Index rose 3.61%. Since inception Glennon Small Companies Ltd has delivered a 25.83% gross portfolio return while the S&P/ASX Small Ordinaries Accumulation Index has also risen 25.83%. At the end of the month the portfolio held 37.25% cash.

Commentary

During December markets were broadly higher with the large caps rising 4.4%, slightly ahead of the 3.6% increase in small caps. Major banks rose, driving large caps performance, but the performance of the banks remains mixed over the past 12 months. Both industrials and resources performed well for both indices, with small cap resources up almost 60% over the calendar year.

The month also saw some positive moves by some of our larger positions. Retail Food Group rose 13% on little news, while G8

Education rose 12% after announcing a trading update and a management reshuffle.
