Service Stream secures a further two-year term on its Wireless Design and Construction Agreement with Vodafone Hutchison Australia

Leading essential network services company Service Stream Limited (ASX: SSM) is pleased to announce that it has successfully secured a further two-year term with Vodafone Hutchison Australia (VHA) for the provision of wireless design and construction services. The contract has been amended to reflect an additional two-year term which will be followed by a two-year extension at VHA's election.

The agreement will see Service Stream continue to partner with VHA as a national provider of services associated with the design and construction of both existing and new wireless infrastructure across Australia.

Whilst the agreement does not provide guaranteed volumes, Service Stream estimates the value of this agreement based on historical revenues to be in the order of \$40-\$50 million over the additional two-year term.

Service Stream's Managing Director, Leigh Mackender, said "We are very pleased to amend our existing agreement for an additional two-year term, further strengthening what has become a long-term relationship between our companies. Service Stream looks forward to continuing to work closely with VHA and supporting its mobile infrastructure programs across the country."
