## Powerhouse seeking further information on 24% owned investee company HydroWorks Limited

Yesterday, PVL halted trading on the ASX following the resignation of Mr Andrew Rodwell as Managing Director of 24% owned investee company HydroWorks Limited, which appeared to leave the Company without any Director. Andrew Rodwell does remain as CEO. PVL notes that the New Zealand Companies Office still shows Mr Rodwell as being a Director of Hydroworks.

The Chairman of Hydroworks Mr Chris Laurie resigned as a Director on Sunday 30 July 2017.

Dr Stephen Hampson, Powerhouse's Manging Director, said PVL is seeking more information on the decision of HydroWorks' directors to resign from the HydroWorks Board.

"We are disappointed at their decision and are seeking a meeting with the company to better understand the reasons. Powerhouse will update shareholders as soon as we have more information.

"Powerhouse is aware HydroWorks has faced significant financial issues in recent months and we recognised it needed active support including the provision of short term finance. Since we became aware of the scope of the business issues earlier this calendar year, we have provided analysis and support where we could.

"Powerhouse has always been a supporter of HydroWorks and we believe there are strong prospects for the company's growth if some changes are made. It has excellent technical capabilities and products to be proud of.

"We are committed to working through this situation with the other HydroWorks' shareholders.

"We will update our shareholders when we have further details," he said.
