The Danish Medicines Agency issued the Marketing Authorisation on 17 January 2018.

MVP CEO, Mr. John Sharman said, "It is exciting to see a further Marketing Authorisation come through so quickly after the initial Iceland approval earlier this week. We expect the remaining 20 countries will issue Marketing Authorisations' to approve the sale of Penthrox in their country over the coming months."
