## Legal Action with Platinum Road / Bridge Road Capital

## Sydney, Tuesday 13 February 2018

Memphasys Limited (MEM) has been named as a defendant in a writ issued in the Supreme Court of Victoria on behalf of former financiers of MEM, Platinum Road Pty Ltd and its related entity, Bridge Road Capital Pty Ltd (together, the Lenders).

The writ claims damages (or in the alternative, monies had and received), interest and costs relating to a series of financing agreements between MEM and the Lenders entered into between March and June 2017 (Loan Agreements). The quantum of the claim is not specified.

Please refer to the Company's 2017 Notice of Annual General Meeting for further details with respect to the Loan Agreements.

Despite a significant period of negotiation, MEM and the Lenders have been unable to come to a consensus as to the exact amount loaned and/or converted and/or due and payable under the various Loan Agreements.

MEM intends to take all necessary action to defend the claim and will keep the market informed as to the status of any proceedings.
