Dear Shareholder

I write to you on behalf of the Molopo board, and I refer to the Notice of Annual General Meeting dated 30 April 2018.

Mr Roger Corbett has expressed concern that a statement on page 7 of the Notice of Annual General Meeting dated 30 April 2018 contains defamatory imputations that:

- i. he is a racist
- ii. he holds views which are not socially acceptable, in that he believes that black men are not equal to white men;
- iii. by reason of his belief that black men are not equal to white men, he is unfit to be a company director.

The Molopo board wish to correct the record and apologise to Mr Roger Corbett AO if anyone took the statement to mean these things. The Molopo board did not intend to convey these imputations.

Mr Corbett's comments, which are referred to at page 7 of the Notice of Annual General Meeting, and were made by him during the ABC 7:30pm Report, were:

"There is a norm of marriage in our community being between a man and a woman. People deeply believe in that. It's not discriminatory in any way. It's a statement that it's between men and women. A man and a man, and a woman and a woman, can have a similar relationship, but it's different. A black man and a white man are equal, but they're clearly different. A black man will never be a white man and vice versa."

Although the Molopo board expressed genuine concerns about whether Mr Corbett's view(s) as expressed in the above quote during the ABC 7.30pm Report reflect modern society's views on those important issues, the Molopo board did not intend to suggest that Mr Corbett was a racist, that he believes that black men are not equal to white men, or that he was unfit to be a company director.
