Request for Voluntary Suspension

buyMyplace.com.au Limited (ASX: BMP) (the Company) requests a voluntary suspension to the trading of the Company's ordinary shares (BMP) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.

The voluntary suspension is requested pending an announcement by the Company to the market regarding a material corporate transaction and associated capital raising.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:
