Nufarm Limited (ASX: NUF) - request for back-to-back trading halts

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.1, Nufarm Limited ACN 091 323 312 ("**Nufarm**") requests that the Australian Securities Exchange ("**ASX**") grant immediate back-to-back trading halts for a total of four trading days with respect to Nufarm's ordinary shares (NUF) and the Nufarm Step-Up Securities (NFNG).

For the purposes of Listing Rule 17.1, I advise that Nufarm:

- (a) requests the trading halts as it expects to make an announcement to the ASX in connection with a capital raising;
- (b) requests that the trading halts remain in place until the earlier of making the announcement to the market about the completion of the capital raising and the commencement of normal trading on Monday, 1 October 2018;
- (c) is seeking the trading halts to assist in managing its disclosure obligations and maintaining an orderly market in the trading of its shares to ensure that trading does not take place in an uninformed market; and
- (d) is not aware of any reason why the trading halts should not be granted, or of any other information available at this stage that is relevant to the trading halts.
