
- The investment will provide Senetas with a majority shareholding on conversion of the full investment

- Senetas investment to fund ongoing investment in sales and marketing as the business scales
- Cash breakeven anticipated in 1H CY20
- Strong revenue growth to US\$3.5M US\$4.0M in CY19 expected to be driven by
 - Senetas investment allowing Votiro to capitalise on global sales pipeline
 - Moving from an upfront license to subscription revenues
 - Securing strategic partnerships, discussion underway
 - Leveraging Senetas distribution relationships in US and Europe
- Investment likely to be initially equity accounted





02

The file is being broken down into its basic objects and analyzes each individual section and metadata while neutralizing any threat.

03

Reconstruct

The cleansed file is reconstructed, while preserving the integrity and functionality of the original file, now safe to save and edit.






