**RE: Response to ASX Price Query**

Further to your letter dated 10 December 2018 we confirm the following:

1. The Company is not aware of any specific information concerning it that has not been announced which, if known, could be an explanation for the recent increase in price or volume in trading in the Company's securities.
2. The Company is not aware of any other specific information which would explain the recent increase in price or volume in trading in the Company's securities. The Company did provide relevant information on its operations in its Annual General Meeting presentation lodged with the ASX on 26 November 2018, and in prior market announcements. The Company is progressing towards finalising the CTP on-time and on-budget for delivery to General Motors Customers in accordance with the announcement dated 30 October 2018.
3. The Company confirms that it continues to be in compliance with the Listing Rules and in particular, Listing Rule 3.1.
4. This response has been approved for release by the Board of the Company.

**Connexion Telematics Ltd (formerly, Connexion Media Limited) ('CXZ'): Price Query**

We note the change in the price of CXZ's securities from a close of \$0.007 on 6 December 2018 to a high of \$0.01 at the time of writing today.

We also note the significant increase in the volume of CXZ's securities traded today.

**Request for Information**

In light of this, ASX asks CXZ to respond separately to each of the following questions and requests for information:

1. Is CXZ aware of any information concerning it that has not been announced to the market which, if known by some in the market, could explain the recent trading in its securities?

If the answer to question 1 is "yes".

- (a) Is CXZ relying on Listing Rule 3.1A not to announce that information under Listing Rule 3.1? Please note that the recent trading in CXZ's securities would suggest to ASX that such information may have ceased to be confidential and therefore CXZ may no longer be able to rely on Listing Rule 3.1A. Accordingly, if the answer to this question is "yes", you need to contact us immediately to discuss the situation.
  - (b) Can an announcement be made immediately? Please note, if the answer to this question is "no", you need to contact us immediately to discuss requesting a trading halt (see below).
  - (c) If an announcement cannot be made immediately, why not and when is it expected that an announcement will be made?
2. If the answer to question 1 is "no", is there any other explanation that CXZ may have for the recent trading in its securities?
  3. Please confirm that CXZ is complying with the Listing Rules and, in particular, Listing Rule 3.1.
  4. Please confirm that CXZ's responses to the questions above have been authorised and approved under its published continuous disclosure policy or otherwise by its board or an officer of CXZ with delegated authority from the board to respond to ASX on disclosure matters.

**When and where to send your response**

This request is made under Listing Rule 18.7. Your response is required as soon as reasonably possible and, in any event, by no later than **2:00 PM AEDT today, Monday, 10 December 2018**. If we do not have your response by then, ASX will likely suspend trading in CXZ's securities under Listing Rule 17.3. You should note that if the information requested by this letter is information required to be given to ASX under Listing Rule 3.1

and it does not fall within the exceptions mentioned in Listing Rule 3.1A, CXZ's obligation is to disclose the information "immediately". This may require the information to be disclosed before the deadline set out in the previous paragraph.

ASX reserves the right to release a copy of this letter and your response on the ASX Market Announcements Platform under Listing Rule 18.7A. Accordingly, your response should be in a form suitable for release to the market. Your response should be sent to me by e-mail at [ListingsComplianceMelbourne@asx.com.au](mailto:ListingsComplianceMelbourne@asx.com.au). It should not be sent directly to the ASX Market Announcements Office. This is to allow me to review your response to confirm that it is in a form appropriate for release to the market, before it is published on the ASX Market Announcements Platform.

### **Listing Rules 3.1 and 3.1A**

Listing Rule 3.1 requires a listed entity to give ASX immediately any information concerning it that a reasonable person would expect to have a material effect on the price or value of the entity's securities. Exceptions to this requirement are set out in Listing Rule 3.1A. In responding to this letter, you should have regard to CXZ's obligations under Listing Rules 3.1 and 3.1A and also to Guidance *Note 8 Continuous Disclosure: Listing Rules 3.1 – 3.1B*. It should be noted that CXZ's obligation to disclose information under Listing Rule 3.1 is not confined to, nor is it necessarily satisfied by, answering the questions set out in this letter.

### **Trading halt**

If you are unable to respond to this letter by the time specified above, or if the answer to question 1 is "yes" and an announcement cannot be made immediately, you should discuss with us whether it is appropriate to request a trading halt in CXZ's securities under Listing Rule 17.1. If you wish a trading halt, you must tell us:

- the reasons for the trading halt;
- how long you want the trading halt to last;
- the event you expect to happen that will end the trading halt;
- that you are not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted; and
- any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt, or that we ask for.

We may require the request for a trading halt to be in writing. The trading halt cannot extend past the commencement of normal trading on the second day after the day on which it is granted.

You can find further information about trading halts in Guidance Note 16 *Trading Halts & Voluntary Suspensions*.

### **Suspension**

If you are unable to respond to this letter by the time specified above ASX will likely suspend trading in CXZ's securities under Listing Rule 17.3.
