

Appointment of Chief Executive Officer of Corio Bay Dairy Group

- Appointment of international dairy leader, Tony Mckenna as CEO of Corio Bay Dairy Group (CBDG)
- CBDG to be Australia's first dedicated organic nutritional powder manufacturer through the construction of the first domestic organic nutritional spray dryer.
- CBDG is a joint venture between the largest and only organic farmers co-op, Organic Dairy Farmers of Australia, Wattle Health Australia and Niche Dairy.

7 March 2019: Wattle Health Australia Limited (WHA:ASX) is pleased to announce the appointment of international dairy leader, Dr. Tony Mckenna to the position of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Corio Bay Dairy Group (CBDG).

Dr. Mckenna has more than 30 years' experience in the dairy industry primarily in nutritionals both domestically and internationally.

Dr. Mckenna's most recent employment was with Saputo Australia as Senior Vice President (Director) of Ingredients, Nutritionals and China and previously was employed by Saputo Australia as Director of Global Business Development of Whey and ingredients.

Dr. Mckenna previously was appointed CEO of Bodco Limited responsible for the establishment and start-up of the business. Main achievements being the restructure of the senior management team, completion of required Chinese registrations including the brand registrations for Nouriz (Shanghai Ltd.) and being part of the project team in the Mataura Valley Milk Plant construction.

Previously Dr. Mckenna was employed at Synlait Milk as General Manager of Market and Development primarily responsible for developing Synlait's infant formula capabilities

including the establishment of the sales team, technical function, initial manufacturing

relationships and strategic sales partnership (including A2 Milk Company).

Dr Mckenna has also been employed by world leading dairy companies including Tatura

Milk Australia as General Manager of Technical and Nutritionals with his primary role being

responsible for infant formula and nutritional sales, and Fonterra as technical manager.

Dr. Mckenna holds a Ph.D. in Food Technology from Massey University and a Diploma in

Management from New Zealand Institute of Management.

Dr. Mckenna, said "I am excited to be leading this new initiative. This is a great opportunity

to drive a high margin business from a differentiated milk source through farm to consumer

partnerships."

About CBDG

CBDG is currently constructing Australia's first dedicated nutritional organic spray dryer in

the Geelong region on land neighbouring ODFA's existing operations. The spray dryer will

have a capacity to be able to process up to 200,000 litres of fresh organic milk per day.

WHA will have a 45% interest in CBDG and Niche Dairy Pty Ltd (Niche), founding partner of

one of the largest nutritional dairy processing plants, Blend and Pack Pty Ltd (B&P), having

a 5% interest in CBDG. ODFA through the guaranteed supply of fresh organic milk to ODFA

will hold 50% of CBDG.



About ODFA

Organic Dairy Farmers of Australia Ltd is a farmer owned Co-Operative (**ODFA**) formed in 2001 by a group of farmers determined to develop organic dairy farming in Australia to differentiate their dairy products from commodity markets and maximise the organic farmgate milk price for co-operative members.

ODFA is a leading supplier of organic milk produced in Australia and comprises certified organic and bio-dynamic farms across the main dairying regions of Victoria.

ODFA farmers are certified organic and they comply with a strict set of standards. They do not use synthetic or artificially produced pesticides, herbicides, fertilisers or GMOs (genetically modified, transgenic organisms). Their cows are fed predominantly on pasture which is completely GMO free. ODFA farmers have a genuine concern about the long-term health of the land and about the herd's welfare. This results in happy cows and remarkable tasting organic milk and dairy products.

Organic production is a holistic system designed to optimise the productivity and fitness of

diverse communities within the agro-ecosystem, including soil organisms, plants, livestock

and people. Organic farming systems aim to develop enterprises that are sustainable and

harmonious with the environment.

The business is experiencing strong growth in demand and has made a strategic decision to

focus on being an ingredient supplier to customers seeking organic milk and dairy powder

products.

Up until 2015, the ODFA co-operative was heavily reliant on contract manufacturing for a

major part of the production of value-added products. These products provided an

opportunity to add value to organic milk returns and manage milk supply. Joint ventures

have been established for the production and marketing of cheese and butter products.

From 2016, the cooperative made its first capital investment in a milk processing plant in

North Geelong. This has been a defining point for the longer-term future of the co-operative.

This plant provides manufacturing capability for valued added products.

The Australian Organic Dairy Centre has significant potential for additional production of

organic dairy products as the co-operative has invested in a specialty cheese plant, new

infrastructure including milk receival and storage and processing of milk separation and

cream pasteurization.

ODFA has a diverse business model with established long-term strategic partnerships with

customers. The co-operative supplies unique organic milk and dairy ingredients to

companies in Australia and overseas who in turn carry the ODFA brand, "True Organic", as

a mark of quality and integrity.
