

- Continued growth in road and street lights (Australian market: 2.28m street and road lights where approximately 10% changed to LED to date)
- Secured approvals for "V" & "P" category road and street lights across states
- Secured supply contracts including VicRoads, RMS, Gold Coast City Council, TasNetworks
- Secured multi year LED road and street supply contracts with power and road authorities in Victoria. New South Wales. South Australia and Queensland
- Secured multi year term maintenance contract for Northern New South Wales for traffic signals, controllers and road lighting

Smart City Platform

- IoT sensors developed for the road industry, councils and power authorities
- Secured supply contracts across New South Wales, Victoria and Queensland
- Secured and deployment of >15,000 IoT nodes/sensors
- Integration and trials for additional road authorities and council assets

Maintenance and Install

- Term maintenance contract for Northern NSW renewed
- Installation of >10,000 LED road lights and IoT nodes in Victoria, New South Wales and Queensland
- · Install crews across eastern states deployed






