## **Corio Bay Dairy Group Update**

- Corio Bay Dairy Group (CBDG) building works continue to develop land stabilisation work completed and the site being prepared for the footings and concrete slab.
- CBDG spray dyer/evaporator build continues and remains on track for shipment in June 2019.
- CBDG is a joint venture between The Organic Dairy Farmers of Australia (ODFA), Wattle Health Australia (WHA) and Niche Dairy (ND) to build Australia's first dedicated organic nutritional spray dryer.
- WHA will be one of the first vertically integrated nutritional organic nutritional dairy company in Australia

**14**<sup>th</sup> **May 2019:** Wattle Health Australia Limited (**WHA** or **Company**), is pleased to provide a progress update on Corio Bay Dairy Group (**CBDG**) and the construction of Australia's first dedicated organic nutritional spray dryer.

Site construction recommenced on 6 May 2019, after land stabilisation work were completed in March 2019. The site is being prepared for the footings and concrete slab, which is the foot print of the factory. Over the coming months the factory will start taking shape as the pre-cast concrete panels and steel works, manufactured in Geelong, Victoria will be erected.



The dryer/evaporator build continues and remains on track for shipment in early June 2019 from India. This first of five shipments will arrive in Melbourne late July 2019, with the final shipment leaving India in September 2019.





Other pieces of plant and equipment are currently also being manufactured both locally and overseas, these include the following; boiler, waste water treatment plant, refrigeration units and powder packing lines.

## **About Corio Bay Dairy Group**

Corio Bay Dairy Group (**CBDG**) is a joint venture between Wattle Health Australia (**WHA**), Niche Dairy (**ND**) and The Organic Dairy Famers of Australia (**ODFA**). CBDG is currently constructing Australia first dedicated organic nutritional spray dryer to process the largest pool of fresh organic milk through an exclusive supply agreement with ODFA. WHA has entered into an agreement to have exclusive supply of all products produced by CBDG to be used across WHA's nutritional dairy range.

**About ODFA** 

ODFA is a farmer owned co-operative formed in 2001 by a group of farmers determined to

develop organic dairy farming in Australia to differentiate their dairy products from commodity

markets and maximise the organic farm-gate milk price for co-operative members.

ODFA is a leading supplier of organic milk produced in Australia and comprises certified

organic and bio-dynamic farms across the main dairying regions of Victoria.

ODFA farmers are certified organic and they comply with a strict set of standards. They do

not use synthetic or artificially produced pesticides, herbicides, fertilisers or GMOs

(genetically modified, transgenic organisms). Cows are fed predominantly on pasture which

is completely GMO free. ODFA farmers have a genuine concern about the long-term health

of the land and about the herd's welfare. This results in contented cows and remarkable

tasting organic milk and dairy products. Organic production is a holistic system designed to

optimise the productivity and fitness of diverse communities within the agro-ecosystem,

including soil organisms, plants, livestock and people. Organic farming systems aim to

develop enterprises which are sustainable and harmonious with the environment.

The business is experiencing strong growth in demand and has made a strategic decision to

focus on being an ingredient supplier to customers seeking organic milk and dairy powder

products.

Up until 2015, the ODFA co-operative was heavily reliant on contract manufacturing for a

major part of the production of value-added products. These products provided an

opportunity to add value to organic milk returns and manage milk supply. Joint ventures have

been established for the production and marketing of cheese and butter products.

From 2016, the co-operative made its first capital investment in a milk processing plant in

North Geelong. This has been a defining point for the longer-term future of the co-operative.

This plant provides manufacturing capability for valued added products.

The Australian Organic Dairy Centre has significant potential for additional production of

organic dairy products as the co-operative has invested in a specialty cheese plant, new

infrastructure including milk receival and storage and processing of milk separation and cream

pasteurization.

ODFA has a diverse business model with established long term strategic partnerships with

customers. The co-operative supplies unique organic milk and dairy ingredients to companies

in Australia and overseas who in turn carry the ODFA brand, "True Organic", as a mark of

quality and integrity.
