Alumina Limited A\$125 million Fixed Rate Notes: Early Redemption

As permitted under the terms and conditions of the Alumina Limited A\$125 million Fixed Rate Notes (the "Notes"), the Company has today redeemed all outstanding Notes at their Outstanding Principal Amount plus interest accrued to today. There was no penalty incurred to redeem the Notes early. Effective today the Company has also early terminated by cash settlement several Cross-Currency Interest Rate Swaps ("CCIRS") which were used to hedge the Notes.

The total cash required to repay the Notes and the CCIRS was equivalent to US\$108.4 million plus accrued interest.

The funds used to repay the Notes and the CCIRS were drawn from an existing bank facility. In June 2019, the bank facility was increased from US\$250 million to US\$350 million and the maturity date was extended. Further details will be provided with Alumina Limited's 2019 Half Year results.
