Please find attached *Form 605 Notice of ceasing to be a substantial holder* for Netwealth Group Limited. (the "Company").

This notice has come about by the ceasing of voluntary escrow arrangements that were put in place in at the time Company listed in November 2017. Under those arrangements 50% of the escrowed shares associated with the interests of Mr Michael Heine and Mr Matthew Heine, and 100 % of the escrowed shares associated with the interests of Mr Leslie Heine ceased on 27 August 2018. The remaining 50% of the escrowed shares associated with the interests of Mr Michael Heine and Mr Matthew Heine ceased on 19 August 2019.
