## ASX ANNOUNCEMENT

### **NAB increases the NAB Capital Notes 4 Offer to at least \$1.95 billion and sets the Margin at 2.95%**

National Australia Bank (NAB) today announced that following the successful completion of the Bookbuild,<sup>1</sup> the NAB Capital Notes 4 Offer will increase from \$750 million to at least \$1.95 billion.

NAB has closed the Bookbuild and allocated \$1.95 billion of NAB Capital Notes 4 under the Broker Firm and Institutional Offers. The Margin has been set at 2.95% per annum, the lower end of the indicative Margin range of 2.95% – 3.15% per annum.

The Offer is expected to open on Tuesday, 25 February 2020. The final size of the Offer may be increased further, subject to Applications received and accepted under the Reinvestment and Securityholder Offers.

The replacement Prospectus containing the Margin and an Application Form is expected to be lodged with ASIC and ASX on 25 February 2020 and will be available within Australia at [www.nab.com.au/ncn4offer](http://www.nab.com.au/ncn4offer) or by calling the **NAB Information Line on 1300 367 647**, Monday to Friday from 8.00am to 7.30pm (Melbourne time) during the Offer Period and for a week following.

The Offer is expected to close on Tuesday, 17 March 2020.

Applications may only be made using the Application Form attached to or accompanying the Prospectus. Investors should read the Prospectus and Terms of the NAB Capital Notes 4 in full before deciding to invest.

For Eligible Securityholders who have registered to receive a paper copy of the Prospectus and a personalised Application Form, mailing is expected to commence on Tuesday, 25 February 2020.
