Market Update

Wattle Health Australia (Wattle Health or the Company) (ASX: WHA) was notified on 17 May 2020 that the

directors of Organic Dairy Farmers of Australia Limited (ODFA) had placed ODFA into voluntary administration

on 15 May 2020, and that Mr Ivan Glavas of Worrells had been appointed as the administrator (ODFA

Administrator). The ODFA Administrator notified Wattle Health by letter dated 18 May 2020 of his

appointment.

The milk supply agreement between ODFA and Corio Bay Dairy Group (CBDG) remains legally binding.

Furthermore, CBDG is now able to source additional fresh organic milk from external parties.

Corio Bay Dairy Group

CBDG continues to work with Shepparton Partners Collective (SPC) who remain engaged to arrange up to

\$20 million of funding for CBDG, as previously announced to the ASX on 1 May 2020.

Wattle Health, Niche Dairy and SPC intend to proceed with CDBG on the basis described below, subject to

due diligence being completed by SPC on CBDG to its satisfaction, definitive legal documentation and

regulatory and shareholder approvals being obtained by all parties.

Previously advanced funds by Wattle Health and Niche Dairy, in the form of shareholder loans, to CDBG will

convert into ordinary shares in CDBG. Upon conversion, CBDG will release Wattle Health and Niche Dairy from

all obligations (including any funding obligations under the facilities agreement). SPC will continue to work

with CBDG to facilitate the provision of up to \$20 million debt funding to complete the construction of the

spray dryer on the CBDG site and will purchase 50.1% of CBDG for a nominal dollar amount, replacing ODFA as

the joint venture partner.

Wattle Health will retain its 45% shareholding in CBDG post the proposed transaction with SPC.

The transaction will allow Wattle Health, CBDG and SPC to work together in completing the construction of

the CBDG spray dryer and move forward with the shared commitment of delivering high quality Australian

farm products.

Commenting on Wattle Health's relationship with SPC and the decision made by ODFA's board of directors,

Wattle Health Chief Executive Officer, Dr Tony McKenna said, "We are very excited about concluding this

transaction with SPC, completing the nutritional spray dryer in Geelong and then commencing the

manufacture of high-quality organic products. We also remain committed to the development of a strong

organic milk supply base and, despite the current challenges of ODFA, dairy farmers will have the opportunity

to supply their organic milk into our spray drying facility at CBDG."
