

- **Finalisation of FY21 Milk Supply Arrangements**
- **AHF Farm converted to A2 herd**

The Board of Australian Dairy Nutritionals Group (the **Group** or **AHF**) is pleased to announce that it has concluded its raw milk supply arrangements with Australian Consolidated Milk for FY21. The new arrangements commence on 1 July 2020 for a period of 12 months.

As foreshadowed in AHF's Market Update released on 19 June 2020, the average raw milk price for conventional milk will be \$6.69 per kg solids and \$8.60 per kg solids for organic milk. Whilst both prices are 8-10% lower than FY20 prices, the Group expects the resulting reduction in milk sales revenue from its farms to be offset by anticipated lower external feed cost prices in FY21.

AHF also advises that it has completed the conversion of one of its farms to a full A2 milk producing herd. This farm is also still in the process of conversion to organic certification.

The release of this announcement was authorised by the Company Secretary, Kate Palethorpe on behalf of the Board of AHF.
