REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT

Cohiba Minerals Limited (ASX: **CHK**) (the **Company**) requests 2 consecutive trading halts (total of up to four trading days) in relation to the Company's ordinary shares and options (CHK and CHKOA) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

The 2 consecutive trading halts are requested pending an announcement by the Company to the market regarding a capital raising ('Purpose').
