Nova Minerals Limited (**Nova or Company**) (**ASX: NVA, OTC: NVAAF, FSE: QM3**) provides the attached Cleansing Statement and Appendix 2A which refer to the issue of shares related to the conversion of an existing Prepayment Funding Facility announced on 28 May 2020 which had a face value of \$2,200,000 and an agreed conversion price of \$0.07 per ordinary share.
