Westpac Debt Assignment to Existing P2P Investor Group

P2P Transport Limited (**P2P** or the **Company**) welcomes the additional ongoing support by a group of existing investors in the Company, including Managing Director Greg Webb, by agreeing to take assignment of Westpac's debt and securities. The assignment completed 21 October 2020.

The investor group has assumed Westpac's rights under the \$4.1m banking facilities the Company previously held with Westpac (the **Facilities**). The terms of the Facilities (including the underlying security originally granted to Westpac) remain unchanged, although the investor group has indicated it intends to work collaboratively to facilitate the ongoing restructure of the Company and does not intend to immediately exercise rights under the Facilities.

This support by the investor group is in addition to the previously announced (25 September 2019) purchase of P2P's Convertible Notes loan facility.

Mr Chip Beng Yeoh, Interim Chairman of P2P, commented that "This debt assignment is a key achievement in the ongoing Strategic Review. It allows the Company a degree of flexibility to determine the best financing solutions for the future strategic direction of the Company. The Company welcomes the additional investment by the investor group at this difficult COVID-19 impacted time".
