First Au Employee Security Ownership Plan

Options have exercise prices and expiry dates as set out in Appendix 3G to which these terms are attached and otherwise have the terms provided for in the First Au Employee Security Ownership Plan ("the Plan") (which terms are incorporated into these terms) as supplemented or varied by or as provided for in the following:

- Each option (an "Option") entitles the holder to acquire one ordinary fully paid share in the capital of the Company (a "Share").
- The exercise price is a price to exercise each Option as set out in Appendix 3G to which these terms are attached.
- The vesting conditions applicable to the Options (if any) are set out in Appendix 3G. If no vesting conditions are set out in Appendix 3G, unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Company and the holder, the Options vest upon issue. Any unvested or any unexercised Options (if the Options vest upon issue) Options will lapse if, prior to vesting, the holder (or in the case of a nominee holder the individual who nominated the holder) ceases to be an employee, consultant (or representative of a consultant that is a company), director or officer of the Company (eligible person) (other than retirement as a director by rotation in accordance with the ASX Listing Rules and/or the Company's Constitution and/or the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) or as may be agreed in writing between the Company and the Holder).

- The options are not transferred, assigned or otherwise dealt with except under the above bullet point or in accordance with clause 10 of the Plan.
- The Options expire at 5pm (Melbourne time) on the date which is two years from the issue date. The Options, if vested and not subject to cancelation or lapse as provided for in these terms (including the Plan as supplemented or varied by these terms), can be exercised by completing an option exercise form and delivering it together with the payment for the number of Shares in respect of which the options are exercised to the Company's share registry.
- Any Option that has not been exercised prior to the expiry date automatically lapses.
- Holders shall not be entitled to exercise their Options (and the Company will not be required to issue shares upon such exercise) if it would be unlawful to do so.
- The exercise price is payable in full on exercise.
- Where an Option holder determines to exercise some, but not all, of their held Options, the total aggregate amount payable to exercise the Options must be a minimum of \$2,000.
