


FY20 Overview




Strategic Review

A company-wide strategic review of operations revealed low growth and profit, and a high demand on the company's resources and the Board resolved to exit the lighting business and concentrate all resources in SKS Technologies.

Overview of Operations

The lighting businesses continued to underperform, delivering a loss to the Group that was exacerbated by the onset of COVID-19.

Lighting

- Completed a wholesale restructure of Urban Lighting in preparation for its sale
- Experienced some disruption from COVID-19, largely with products sourced from China, resulting in delays and cancellations
- Street Lighting business sold in January 2020 for a total price of \$3.1 million.
- Commercial lighting sold in July 2020 for \$0.865 million, including all bolt-on acquisitions, such
 as Lumex and the LumiGrow supply agreement



Overview of Operations

SKS Technologies continued to return the lion's share of Enevis profits and is now the sole focus with its national presence, excellent major project track record and industry-leading capability.


SKS Technologies

FY20 Restructure Program

Following the strategic review, a companywide restructure program was implemented, resulting in divestments, cost cutting initiatives, new systems, a capital raising and debt reduction.


